The Manor House Series features four styles: Regal, Tradition, Savoy, and Chateau. They are available in a variety of patterns, window and decorative hardware options, and an insulation option.

The Standard Panel Series offers four raised-panel and flush door designs: Classic, Venice I, Venice II, and Westwood. The Standard Panel Series also offers an optional insulation package.
