ChetanSix KI Facilities Earn FSC Chain of Custody Certification

Six of KI's manufacturing facilities in the United States and Canada recently received Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) Chain of Custody (COC) certification from Scientific Certification Systems (SCS). This designation certifies KI can sell wood products conforming to FSC standards, which traces wood from forests through all stages of processing and distribution. KI's unique FSC certification code is SCS-COC-002476.

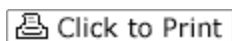

KI was awarded FSC-COC certification following an extensive, independent audit of its wood manufacturing supply chain by SCS, the top FSC certifier in the United States and a leading third-party environmental certification body. SCS examined KI's quality systems, wood and fiber sourcing, production controls and record keeping, labeling, and documentation.
